

Bill's Avenue of Service

Club Service: Bill was inducted into Rotary in 2005 and has chaired and co-chaired the fundraising events, chaired the Service Projects Committee, served on the Scholarship, Community Service, Photography and Strategic Planning Committees and started the New Members Committee. He became a Paul Harris Fellow in 2012. Bill has the record of bringing in the most members in our Club's recent memory. He has participated in all activities this year and led many of them. He has a 100% attendance at Club and Board meetings.

Vocational: Bill is a man of integrity. He is a lawyer by profession and has used his skills and expertise to update the RCWP bylaws, dedicating many hours to an almost rewrite. He has been instrumental in the development of RCWP's submission of legislations and resolutions to the Council on Legislation and in the submission of an amendment to the District 7230 MAP, which was passed at the recent District Conference. Bill started networking meetings in our Club which became a District event and is now part of the RI's Rotary Means Business Fellowship.

He applied for and received a District grant for back packs for children. He has actively participated in all of RCWP's community service activities. He signed up our Club to participate in a Fun Run which benefited the Blythedale Hospital for Children.

International: Bill is an International Director of Rotary Means Business. Though Gift of Life, Bill helps to bring in children from other countries for life saving heart operations. Just recently, he spoke so passionately about a child who was brought in from Kosovo. He facilitated and participated in the initial discussion on developing a women's health initiative in association with Albert Einstein College of Medicine. Our Club often gets requests for housing from members of Clubs (for families and associates) in other countries who are visiting/participating in educational and/or internship programs in the New York area. Bill is the go to person who contacts people through his Networking to help fill these requests. Bill thoroughly vets these people by contacting the international Clubs to ensure that the requests are legitimate. He has successfully assisted in placing international young adults in local housing.

Youth Service: Bill serves on our Strategic Planning Committee which was instrumental in the Club starting cocktail meetings to attract younger members. Through Bill's effort and contact with the president of the YMCA, we are in the process of establishing the Rotaract Club of the White Plains YMCA. Bill is so enthusiastic about bringing young members into the Club that he follows what's going on with them in the newspaper and other publications and attends meeting where there are gatherings of young people.

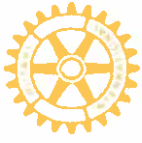
